### Rock Bridge

This historic bridge connects the Cahaba Project and the Cahaba dog park, Trussville Senior Activity Center, disc golf course, and the Trussville Sports Complex.

Rock Bridge was built in 1936 with sandstone sourced from a rock quarry in Rock Creek Park, north of the 200 block of Brentwood Ave.

Also made of this sandstone, the original gazebo entrance to the Cahaba Project stands at the corner of Parkway Drive and Hwy 11.



### Heritage Hall

Since 1938, Heritage Hall has served local residents as a library, community center, general store, co-op, and filling station.

It is now home to ACTA community theater and the Trussville Historical Museum.

# I. Chalkville at Poplar and Rockridge intersection





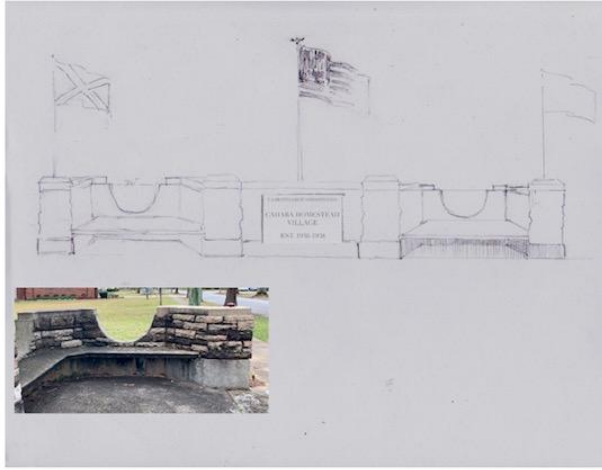


## II. Parkway and Poplar Intersection

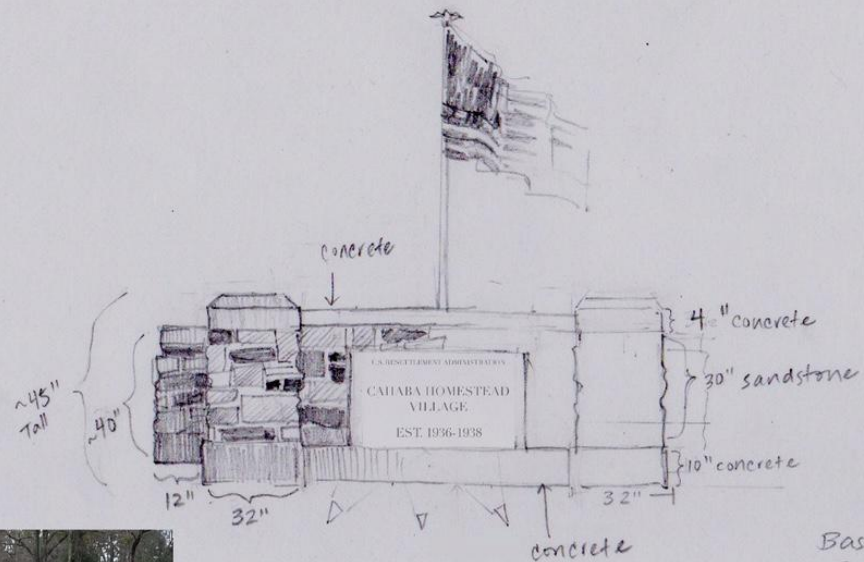
